Camp Duties (learning to serve)

- Have youth rotate to do the jobs
- MC to make sure youth are at the Duty
- Make it fun for the youth
- Youth could do it with non-indigenous team help too

1. Collect Wood for cooks and camp fires

- a. Vehicle Need a license driver in the team and the trailor
 - i. No kids to sit in the trailor!
- b. No trailor go into bush looking for wood

2. Toilets and showers - check 3 times a day for toilet paper

- Cleaning to be done with camp helpers (afternoon) and last day.
 - Clean hand basins
 - clean toilet
 - wipe toilet flush button area and seat
 - Sweep and mop (or hose out if practical)
 - empty rubbish and replace with new plastic bag.
 - renew toilet paper supply

3. Cooking area

Help with preparing vegetables, jobs that the cooks want done Cooking Damper

4. Cleaning up

- Sweep area for meeting, etc.
- Help with clean up after an activity.

Rubbish

- a. Make sure they have garbage bags
- b. New rubbish bags put in after each meal
- c. Collect rubbish bags from bins and putt in one area
- d. Have kids pick up rubbish for points and put in bin (specially on the last day)
- e. Leader to organise drop off on last day (and other days) of camp using the trailor
