

All Leaders

Before Camp/Leadership Training

- Christian – Shows they love Jesus & each other
- Heart for youth
- Servant heart
- Faithful, Available, Teachable, Respect, Mature
- Ask a young adult from your community to come with you (if possible)

Safe team:

- Ochre Card – working with Children cards – need all leaders to have this
- Work as a team – unity
- Know the Emergency plan
- Talked through Rules/Discipline – what happens when kids break rules?

I.e Do you sit down with a leader in the naughty shade tree and miss out on program?

- Touching - Child should always initiate contact

Roles

- Take on roles before camp, as well as at camp
- Participate in Camp
- Attend leaders meetings & prayer times
- Make sure others keep the rules (including making sure everyone has gone to bed in your community).
- Youth are watching you – be available for them to talk to you
 - Say Sorry Publically
 - Praying together
 - Not cheating
 - Show a different way to live
 - Correct each other
 - Serve
- Talk, pray and encourage others on the team (or could be Pastoral team)

- **Follow up after camp**

- Discipleship after camp?

- Follow up youth who have given their heart to the Lord - help them grow in their faith, pray with them.
- Memory Verse - keep doing with youth
- Activities to keep doing back in community
- What do you want to teach the youth? What do they struggle with?
- Need to keep feeding them
- Watch past youth camp videos on youtube - aboriginalbibles
- Do challenges:
 - Make an action dance
 - Send a letter with a scripture to a friend
 - Start walking
 - Doing Gardening
- Bush Camps
 - For local young people, from maybe one or two communities
 - Hold nearer their community
 - Something they will run themselves
- Help another group of communities run a youth camp (if they are interested).

They may come to your youth camp to see how it is run.
