There are four possible responses to risk levels:

1. Leave things as they are, if the risk is acceptable.
2. Use strategies to reduce the risk to an acceptable level.
3. Avoid the activity, if risk cannot be reduced to an acceptable level.
4. Transfer the risk e.g. to a more skilled leader.
